This course offers a study of the history of the modern world and Australia from 1918 to the present, with an emphasis on Australia in its global context. As well as a general overview of period, the course requires that students participate in three in-depth studies including World War II, Rights and Freedoms, and the Globalising World. A primary aim of the course will be for students to respond to inquiry questions through interpretation of sources, descriptions of past events and explanations of various historical perspectives.

Assessment

Assessment will be continuous and varied in nature. There will be a variety of assessment pieces that focus on inquiry, questioning and historical argument. These may include source analyses, empathy writing and historical essays.
