Information, Media and Technology (IMAT) is a specialist, 2-year Industry Pathways Program (IPP). The course caters to a wide range of interests and career pathways. Students engage in industry learning where they explore programming, graphic design, photography, 3D modelling, animation, computer engineering, software design, robotics, VR, game design and as the workforce continues to develop into a digital and technological space. This course allows students to develop towards, adapt to and improve upon any career path they choose now and into the future through the application of skills that are important in a wide range of workplaces. These foundation skills ensure that students can go on to successfully complete further study in this field with confidence.

Entry requirements:

- Pass grade in Year 10 EIF, English and Maths
- C grade average in subjects
- 80% Attendance
- Positive behaviour for learning within school
- Successful participation in the VETRO practice assessment
- Evidence of Industry Immersion exploring the identified pathway
- Passing VETRO to required exit score
- Signing of the code of contact
- Completion of enrolment forms
