College Updates

Immunisations

All year 7 and 8 students will be offered:

1 dose of human papillomavirus vaccine/Gardasil® 9 at 2 separate visits.

1 dose of the diphtheria, tetanus, whooping cough vaccine, Boostrix®

All Year 10 students will be offered:

2 doses of the meningococcal B vaccine, Bexsero® at 2 separate visits.

1 dose of the meningococcal ACWY vaccine, Nimenix®

Immunisation consent packs have been sent home with students. It is important you read the information contained in the packs before you give consent/no consent, so that you understand the facts about the vaccines that will be offered and the diseases that these vaccines protect against. If you have any questions about this program, please contact Whyalla City Council's Immunisation Coordinator 8640 3444.

All parents/legal guardians are required to complete, sign and return the consent cards, even if you don't consent for the student to be vaccinated at school, cards are to be returned to the school by **Wednesday 15 February 2023**.
