Allied, Health, Education, Aged, Disability



AHEAD is a specialised Industry Pathways Program (IPP) for students interested in careers within the Health and Education sectors, including:

- Disability Support
- Education: Early Childhood, Preschool, Primary, and Secondary
- Aged Care
- Nursing / Midwifery
- Allied Health: Social Work, Speech Pathology, Psychology, and related fields

The program follows a project-based learning model, focusing on real-world experiences in health and education. Students play an active role in running the Whyalla Secondary College crèche and supporting various school and community events. They also gain valuable experience through community projects and industry work placements.



Entry requirements:

- C grade or above in year 10 EIF (Exploring Identities and Futures), English and Maths
- C grade average in subjects
- 80% attendance
- Positive behaviour for learning within school
- Successful participation in the VETRO (VET Readiness Orientation)
- Evidence of Industry Immersion exploring the identified pathway
- Signing of the Code of Conduct
- Completion of enrolment forms
- Participate in interview application process

Entry requirements at the discretion of the college

SACE/ATAR attainment:

Estimated 50 credits at SACE Stage 1.

This IPP course can be used to gain an ATAR.

Anticipated VET duration: 12-18 months
