Cookery, Hospitality and Tourism



CHAT is a specialised Industry Pathways Program (IPP) designed for students interested in pursuing careers in:

- Food and Beverage
- Cookery
- Tourism
- Business / Event Management
- Marketing

With a strong focus on business and enterprise management, this program uses a project-based learning approach to develop practical skills and industry knowledge. Students take the lead in operating the Whyalla Secondary College on-site café and provide catering for various school and community events, gaining hands-on experience in a real-world setting. They also gain valuable experience through industry work placements.

Entry requirements:

- C grade or above in year 10 EIF (Exploring Identities and Futures), English and Maths
- C grade average in subjects
- 80% attendance
- Positive behaviour for learning within school
- Successful participation in the VETRO (VET Readiness Orientation)
- Evidence of Industry Immersion exploring the identified pathway
- Signing of the Code of Conduct
- Completion of enrolment forms
- Participate in interview application process

Entry requirements at the discretion of the college

SACE/ATAR attainment:

Estimated 50 credits at SACE Stage 1.

This IPP course can be used to gain an ATAR.

Anticipated VET duration: 12 months
