This program is designed to meet the rapidly growing demand for digital and technological expertise in today's evolving workforce. Through hands-on, project-based learning experiences, students develop a diverse set of future-ready skills that are transferable across a wide range of industries including entertainment, engineering, education, design, IT, and beyond.

Entry requirements:

- C grade or above in year 10 EIF (Exploring Identities and Futures), English and Maths
- C grade average in subjects
- 80% attendance
- Positive behaviour for learning within school
- Successful participation in the VETRO (VET Readiness Orientation)
- Evidence of Industry Immersion exploring the identified pathway
- Signing of the Code of Conduct
- Completion of enrolment forms
- Participate in interview application process

Entry requirements at the discretion of the college

SACE/ATAR attainment:

Estimated 50 credits at SACE Stage 1.

This IPP course can be used to gain an ATAR.
