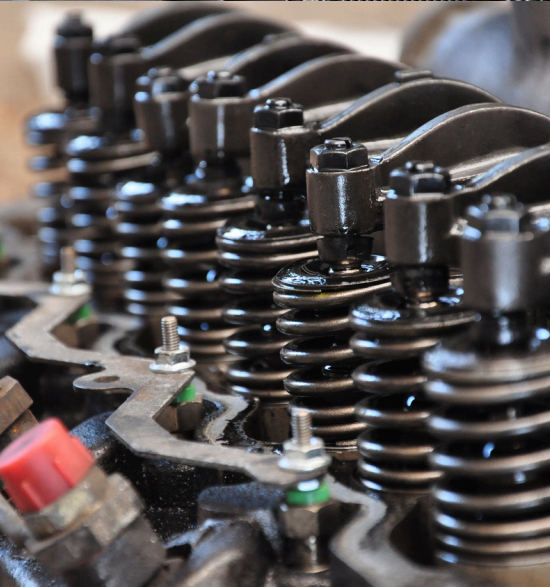


Certificate II in Automotive Servicing Technology
