

Certificate II in Construction Pathways

Description:

This certificate II qualification is an introduction to construction trades which includes carpentry, bricklaying and tiling providing a pathway to the primary trades in the construction industry.

Employment Outcomes:

This qualification provides a pathway to the primary trades in the construction industry with the exception of plumbing. Trade outcomes are predominantly achieved through an Australian Apprenticeship.

Entry requirements:

C grade or above in year 10 EIF (Exploring Identities and Futures), English and Maths

SACE attainment:

Students can gain between 40- 55 Stage 1 SACE credits on completion of this qualification, dependent on units chosen.

Anticipated VET duration: 12 months
