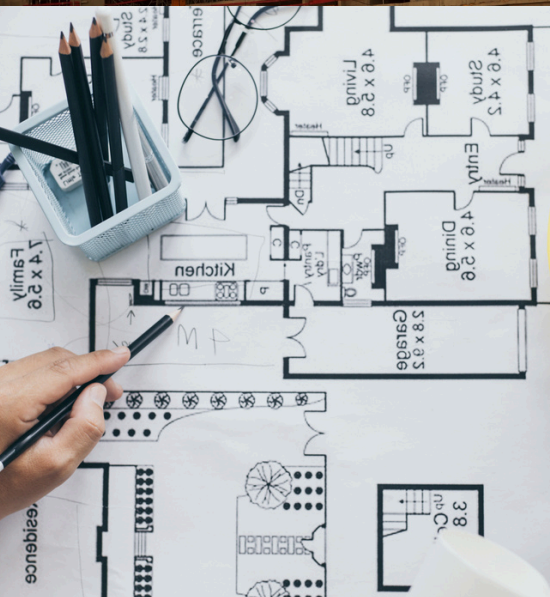


# Certificate II in Engineering Pathways
