Dear Parents, Caregivers and Families,

He was a fantastic speaker, talking to the students about the importance of staying in school, attending every day, learning to read and write and be numerate, as well as keeping out of trouble. Our students are extremely lucky to have had this opportunity.

One of the most important topics Eddie talked about was going to school every day so that you can reach your full potential. 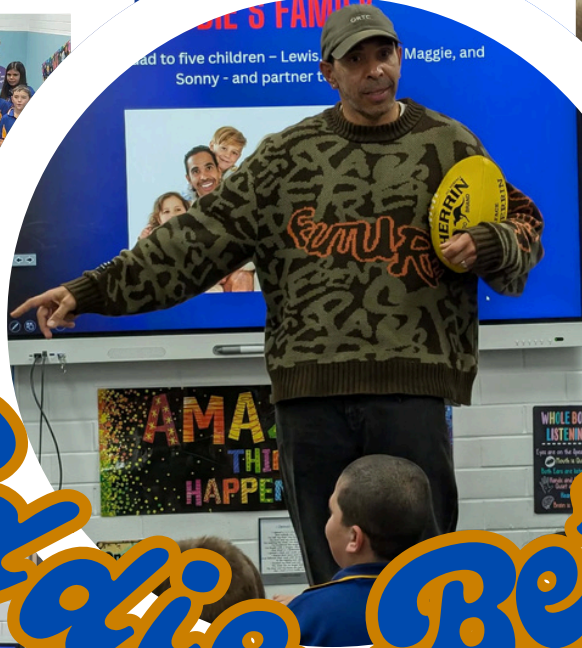
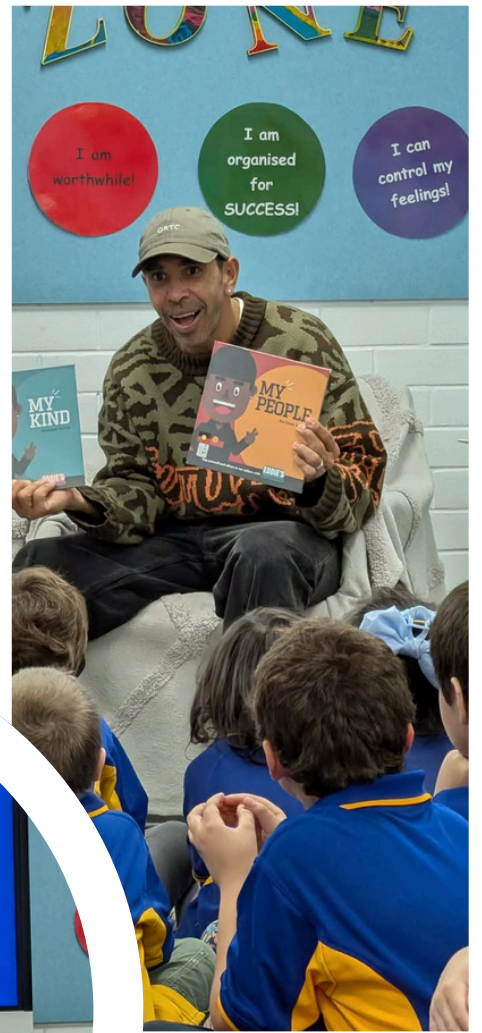

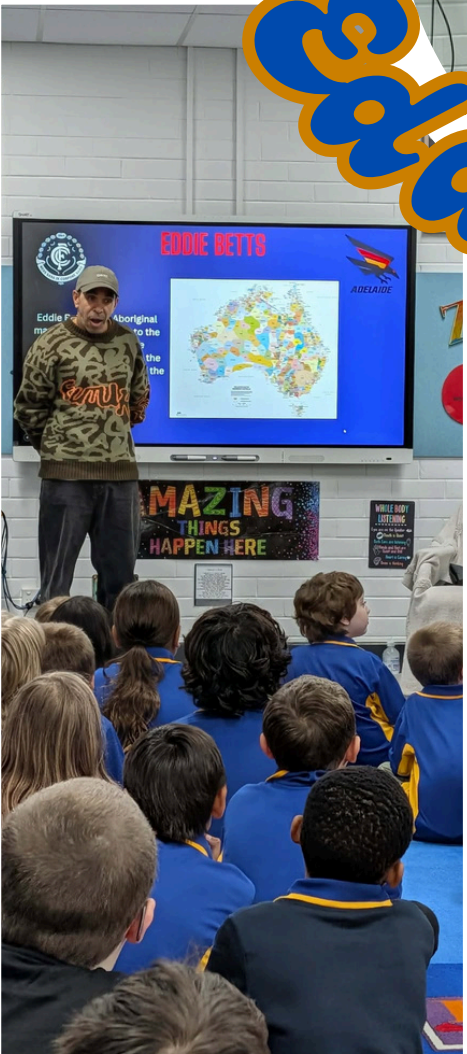
